

Anorectal Surgery

Please remember to read through all the pre-operative instructions. As it is pertinent to your upcoming procedure. If you should not follow the instructions, it could lead to your procedure being cancelled or rescheduled.

The following medications are used to prep for your procedure.

2-BOTTLES fleet enemas, they are over the counter and can be purchased at your local pharmacy.

Preparing for your Anorectal Surgery

Days Prior

- Stop all blood thinning and anti-inflammatory medications. As directed in your pre-operative instructions.
- If you smoke, please STOP at minimum 2 weeks prior to your procedure.

1 Day Prior

- Take one fleet enema at bedtime.
- Fasting after midnight. This includes no water or food of any kind.

Morning of Your Procedure

- Maintain fasting- no water no food.
- Take one fleet enema 2 hours prior to driving in for your procedure.

Day of Your Procedure

- You will need a driver to and from your procedure. The driver will be allowed to enter the facility. Once you are starting the discharge process a nurse will contact your driver.
- Leave all valuables at home.
- Call our office to schedule a 3 week follow up.

Things to keep in mind...

- NO SHOWS-If you no show to your surgery you will be subject to a \$150.00 NO SHOW fee. The provider will need to see you in the office before another date is set. The fee must also be paid in full.
- **RESCHEDULING**-We understand life happens but rescheduling a surgical procedure can be difficult as there are many moving pieces. Please be mindful of rescheduling your procedure, to avoid any charges you should reach out to your scheduler within 1 week of your procedure to reschedule, otherwise you could be subject to a \$75.00 rescheduling fee. Please keep in mind the NO SHOW fee of \$150.00.
- **FEES**-Our office is only responsible for quoting our own fees. Even then so, the estimate we provide is an estimate. If you are subject to deductible, coinsurance, or out of pocket we will contact to go over the amount with you. If you have a surgical copay or deductible, that will be collected by our office billing department 7 days prior to procedure.
- FMLA/Short Term Paperwork-Our office charges a \$75.00 fee for any paperwork. This fee can be paid at the time of your surgery being scheduled, or upon completion our office will contact you for payment. Please allow our office 7 business days to process paperwork. Paperwork will not be completed till after procedure has been completed.
